School Ranking

Using 2011 *Newsweek* magazine's criteria for public high schools, CCHS Ranking would be in the top 3 in California and top 45 in the nation. Following the *Washington Post's* "power rankings", CCHS would be in the top 10 in California and top 75 in the nation.

Enrollment

Current high school enrollment is 217 students:
Freshmen = 45 Sophomores = 51 Juniors = 70 Seniors = 51
About 60% of the students have English Language Learner backgrounds.

Grade Point Average

The grade point average for college admissions is calculated on a 4.0 scale and includes all academic courses in grades 10 through 12. An extra grade point is awarded to AP and UC-approved honors classes. The transcript grade point calculation includes only courses taken at Chinese Christian High School.

Student Ranking

CCHS only ranks the top 10% of each graduating class.

Academic Policy

- With limited exceptions, students are required to take 5 academic classes and a one unit Bible class every semester.
- Restrictions for AP Classes

In order to promote comprehensive and balanced development of academic and non-academic pursuits, CCS generally limits the number of AP and honors classes a student may enroll in. The following guideline is used:

2.7-3.0 gpa – 1 AP/honors classes

3.0-3.5 gpa – 2 AP/honors classes

3.5-4.0 gpa – 3 or 4 AP/honors classes
