[Campus Tours]	During the program, students will have the opportunity to visit some of California's top universities including the University of California Berkeley and Stanford University.
[Schedule]	Morning Classes include lessons on American Holidays, Values, Traditions, and Relationships. Afternoon Activities include campus tours and other fun activities around the Bay Area.
